

## Eagles Nest-After School Care

Any Bethany Academy student who has not been picked up by 3:15 p.m. will be directed to the Eagles' Nest for supervision until their ride arrives. Any student who is under the direct supervision of their parent(s) at the time the building is locked (3:15 p.m.) will not be allowed to re-enter the building without consent from the office.

The Eagles Nest is completely supported by the fees charged to families for the supervision services rendered, therefore, families will be billed accordingly and will be held responsible for payment. The cost per family, per day will be:

\$10 from 3:15 p.m. up to 4:00 p.m.

\$15 from 3:15 p.m. up to 5:00 p.m.

\$25 from 3:15 p.m. up to 5:30 p.m.

Families will be billed through their TADS account. All students must be picked up by 5:30 p.m.

Important information/expectations regarding the Eagles' Nest:

- The school must have the most updated medical and emergency information concerning your student on file in the event that an accident or injury would occur during your students' time in the Eagles' Nest. Should an accident or injury occur, the Eagles' Nest staff will follow established school procedures to ensure your student receives the proper and appropriate care that is needed.
- The Eagles' Nest is completely supported by the fees charged to families for the supervision services rendered, therefore, families will be billed accordingly and will be held responsible for payment. Families will be billed through their TADS account. The Eagles' Nest rates are as follows: \$10 from time spent within the 3:15 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. timeframe per family per day; \$15 from time spent within the 3:15 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. timeframe per family per day; and \$25 from time spent within the 3:15 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. timeframe per family per day. All students must be picked up by 5:30 p.m.
- All students must sign in on the appropriate form each day providing the date, their name, and the time they entered the Eagles' Nest. Upon exiting the Eagles' Nest for the day students need to be signed out by a parent or an individual who has been preapproved to pick up the student and the Eagles' Nest has received prior notification of the approval.. The sign out process includes the parent's signature, and time of departure from the Eagle's Nest. If a parent chooses, they may call 952-831-8686, extension 124 to verbally sign out their student with the Eagles' Nest Staff, who will in turn record the proper data on the form and will release the students.
- The Eagle's Nest does not provide snacks for the students. Parents may send in a snack for their student to eat while in the Eagle's Nest.

- Families who use the Eagle's Nest on a consistent basis are asked to provide the Eagle's Nest staff with weekly usage schedule and estimated pick up times by emailing [erica.h322@gmail.com](mailto:erica.h322@gmail.com) or via text or voicemail at 612-272-1948.
- Families who use the Eagle's Nest on a day to day basis are asked to notify the school office (952-831-8686) or by emailing [erica.h322@gmail.com](mailto:erica.h322@gmail.com) or text or voicemail at 612-272-1948 regarding attendance and estimated pick up time.
- Students are expected to 1) show respect to the Eagles' Nest staff and to all participating students; 2) use self-control; 3) work on any homework they may have before participating in activities provided; 4) follow directions; 5) clean up after each activity they participate in; and 6) behave appropriately and in accordance to the Academy's policies as stated in the school handbook.
