Intro to Computer Modeling and 3D Printing Camp

June 11-15

This course is open to students from 6th grade up. It will include an introduction to an online CAD program called Tinkercad, a math graphing program called DESMOS and the use of Bethany's 3D printer. Students will learn how to create designs of their own using computer software that is easy to learn but powerful for creating designs using basic geometric shapes. They will also learn how to make shapes of their own using math equations and a graphing software package called DESMOS. They will print their designs on our 3D printer. It is not necessary to know high level math to enjoy this activity. This camp is an opportunity for students who have not yet used the 3D printer in math class to learn how a 3D printer works. We will spend the time using computers in our math classroom at Bethany and printing the students designs. Students who have already used our 3D printer are invited to attend along with beginners.
